TO RECEIVE WEEKLY OR END OF YEAR CHILD CARE

BENEFIT:

- You need to contact Centrelink and register.
- You need to supply us with your date of birth, your family CRN and your child/children's CRN.
- You need to advise us if you have another child in care along with their name, date of birth, and CRN or you will be charged for a single child fee.
- You need to be exact with all information i.e. full names not nicknames or names known by.
- Parent name and CRN on form must be the parent registered with Centrelink.

Safeguarding Children & Young People

PLEASE NOTE

- Accounts must be paid in full prior to your child attending
- Office hours for payments are 9.00am to 4.00pm Monday to Friday
- Camp Warrawee is a large open bush land area unlike most fenced school vacation care venues
- Due to the outdoor adventure activities offered, children must have turned six (6) before they will be accepted at this vacation care program.
- Children must be signed in on arrival and signed out on departure from Vacation care
- Written notification is required for anyone other than authorised persons on your application form to collect your child/ren. Photo identification will be required
- All children must be collected by 5.30pm or late fees will apply.
- Parents are required to sign for any absent days on the attendance register
- No confirmation is posted out, however if you wish to confirm your booking please phone 3882 1436 or email camp.warrawee@ymcabrisbane.org
- Please advise us prior to Vacation care of any specific medical diagnosis and/or special needs and include a behaviour management plan if necessary. This is for your child's benefit and allows us to better manage their condition.
- Children with special dietary requirements are asked to bring their own bread and snacks
- For complaints please contact Vacation Care Coordinator by phone (07 38821436) or email camp.warrawee@ymcabrisbane.org.au
In person at the service can only be by appointment.
- Any child/ren found through their behaviour to be endangering the safety or emotional or physical health of anyone involved with the service are excluded from attending. If this should occur fees are not refunded
- If a child has acted inappropriately and damaged equipment or property belonging to the YMCA Vacation Care program or YMCA centre, the child's parent or guardian may be charged for the replacement of the damaged item
- Due to the complex nature of CCMS funding, and coupled with staffing ratios, cancellations, once a booking has been made, will only be accepted with two weeks notice, or with the approval of the Coordinator of the Vacation Care Program.

Old clothes are recommended

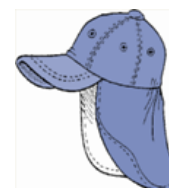
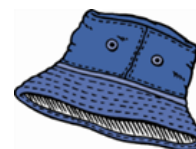
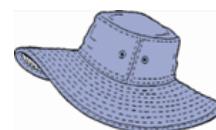
- Day pack to carry belongings in
